<i>Visit Chinatown in Liverpool City Centre. Draw a picture/create a model of the large gate there.</i>	<i>5</i>
<i>Find out something about the country of China. Present your findings in a booklet or poster.</i>	<i>5</i>
<i>The Chinese community in Liverpool is one of the oldest in the country. Find out about its history.</i>	<i>5</i>
<i>Find out about the stones used to build some of our famous Liverpool buildings- Eg St George's Hall, the Museum, the Walker Art Gallery. Build a model of one of our iconic Liverpool buildings.</i>	<i>5</i>
<i>Create your own fossil at home using modelling clay or salt dough.</i>	<i>5</i>
<i>Visit Crosby beach and go on a rock scavenger hunt to see how many different rocks you can find.</i>	<i>5</i>
