



Remote learning timetable

As stated in our home learning policy, pupils are expected to complete at least 3 hours learning a day in Reception and KS1 and 4 hours in KS2. We provide 4 – 5 hours each day which equates to the learning time that pupils would receive in school. The timetable below sets out the learning that your child will need to complete each day and how we will provide feedback. Your Child's Class Teacher will contact you on a weekly basis to discuss any concerns that you might have. If you have any questions or queries, please contact a member of staff through your child's year group email and they will get back to you as quickly as they can.

Daily Timings – KS1

Time/ Suggested time	Lesson	Information
20 minute s 8:45a m	Morning Arithmetic	Your child will have 10 arithmetic questions to complete on the squared paper provided. Your child should set this out themselves. Jottings, pictures or objects that you have at home can be used to support with this.
45 minute s	Phonics	Videos will be posted to Google Classroom to teach the pronunciation, and strategies that the children need to read. They will have opportunities to spell these words which they should complete in their yellow exercise book. They can also put some of these words into sentences in their neatest handwriting. Photographs of this work should be uploaded to Google Classroom.
1 hour	English	Videos and images will be posted into Google Classroom to form the basis of the lesson. Instructions will be posted onto the Powerpoint that is uploaded to Google Classroom each day. Teachers will provide feedback and give next steps to enable children to further develop their work next time.
20-30 mins	Reading	Your child completes 20 minutes of reading at school each day and this needs to continue at home. Oxford Owl Class logins have been provided on the front of your Google Classroom folder label, along with the colour of your child's reading book. Instructions of how to access these texts have also been included in your home learning folders.
1 hour	Maths	Your child's class teacher will put White Rose or the Oak Academy Maths teaching video links onto the Powerpoint that is uploaded to Google Classroom. There will be worksheets linked to each lesson for your child to complete. These will be uploaded to Google Classroom for pupils to complete on screen.
20-30 mins	Maths fluency and basic number skills	Your child has logins for both Doodle Maths and Timestable Rockstars. Your child should complete daily sessions for these online learning platforms for the recommended time. Your child's class teacher will monitor their progress as they complete this at home. If you have any issues accessing these platforms, please contact us via the year group email address.
1 hour	Science and non-core subjects	Your child's class teacher will share a list of other subject areas and learning tasks for your child to continue their learning across the curriculum. This will be in a range of subjects, for example science, art, DT, PSHE, RE, history, geography etc. It will not be every one of these subjects, it will depend on what
